2. The abstract should not exceed 200 words including title.
3. Full length papers should be between 2000-3000 words.
4. Soft copy of the paper should be uploaded on link which will be shared in whatsapp group.
5. Paper must be typed in 12 point font size, Times New Roman with 1.5 line spacing in MS Word along with the name and address of the author, contact no. and email id.
6. References must be in the form of latest MLA/APA standards.
7. Last dates for abstract submission: 26.02.22 and full paper submission: 02.03.22.

Selected papers will be published in book form bearing ISBN.
